Phrasal verbs with get

Phrasal Verb	Tłumaczenie	Przykładowe zdanie
get across	przekazać, wytłumaczyć	He tried to get his point across, but no one listened.
get along with	dogadywać się z	She gets along with her coworkers very well.
get around	poruszać się	It's easy to get around the city by bike.
get away	uciec	We managed to get away for a few days of relaxation.
get away with	uniknąć kary	He often gets away with being late to work.
get back	wrócić	I'll get back home by 7 PM.
get behind	mieć zaległości	She got behind on her rent payments.
get by	radzić sobie	They don't earn much, but they get by.
get down	schodzić	He got down from the ladder carefully.
get dressed	ubrać się	Hurry up and get dressed, we're late!
get even	zemścić się	He planned to get even with his rival.

get in	wejść, wsiąść	He got in the car and drove away.
get off	wysiadać, zejść	We need to get off at the next stop.
get on	wsiąść, radzić sobie	She got on the bus just in time.
get on with	kontynuować	Let's get on with the next item on the agenda.
get out	wychodzić	She told him to get out of her room.
get over	dojść do siebie	It took him months to get over the breakup.
get through	przetrwać, dodzwonić się	We managed to get through the storm safely.
get together	spotkać się	We should get together for a coffee sometime.
get up	wstawać	He gets up early every morning.

Phrasal verbs with **put**

Phrasal Verb	Tłumaczenie	Przykładowe zdanie
put across	przekazać	She managed to put her ideas across clearly.
put away	odłożyć	Please put away your toys after playing.
put back	odłożyć na miejsce	Can you put the book back on the shelf?
put by	odkładać (oszczędzać)	She puts by a little money each month.
put down	odłożyć, zapisać	He put down the heavy bag. / She put down her thoughts in a diary.

put forward	proponować	She put forward a new plan for the project.
put in	włożyć (np. wysiłek)	He put in a lot of effort into his work.
put off	odkładać (na później)	Don't put off your homework until the last minute.
put on	zakładać (ubranie)	He put on his coat and left the house.
put out	zgasić	The firefighters put out the fire quickly.
put through	połączyć (telefonicznie)	Can you put me through to the manager?
put together	złożyć	He put together the new furniture by himself.
put up with	znosić, tolerować	She can't put up with his bad behavior anymore.

Phrasal verbs with take

Phrasal verb	Tłumaczenie	Przykładowe zdanie
take after	być podobnym do	She takes after her mother in terms of personality.
take apart	rozmontować	He took apart the engine to see what was wrong with it.
take away	zabierać	The waiter took away our plates after we finished eating.
take back	zwrócić (np. towar)	He took back the shirt because it didn't fit.

take down	zapisać, zdjąć (np. notatkę, zasłonę)	She took down the important points during the lecture. / We need to take down the Christmas decorations.
take for	wziąć za, uważać za	I took her for a doctor because of her white coat.
take in	zrozumieć, przyjąć (np. informację), przechytrzyć	He couldn't take in all the information at once. / She took in stray cats and dogs.
take off	startować (o samolocie), zdjąć (np. ubranie)	The plane took off on time. / It's hot; I need to take my jacket off.
take on	podjąć się, przyjąć na siebie (np. zadanie, obowiązek)	She took on extra responsibilities at work.
take out	wyjąć, zabrać na miasto (np. osobę)	He took out a book from the shelf. / Let's take out the kids for ice cream.
take over	przejąć kontrolę, objąć władzę (nad czymś)	The new manager took over after the old one retired.
take up	zająć się (np. nowym hobby), podjąć (np. temat)	She took up painting as a hobby. / He took up the issue with the board of directors.
take after	być podobnym do	She takes after her mother in terms of personality.
take apart	rozmontować	He took apart the engine to see what was wrong with it.

Phrasal verbs with *look*

Phrasal verb	Tłumaczenie	Przykładowe zdanie
look after	opiekować się	She looks after her younger sister after school.

look ahead	patrzeć w przyszłość	It's important to look ahead and plan for the future.
look away	odwrócić wzrok	She looked away when the scary part of the movie came on.
look back on	wspominać	He looks back on his childhood with fondness.
look down on	patrzeć z góry na	They shouldn't look down on people who have less than them.
look for	szukać	She's looking for her keys; have you seen them?
look forward to	nie móc się doczekać	I'm really looking forward to the weekend.
look into	zbadać, przyjrzeć się	The police will look into the matter further.
look over	przejrzeć	Please look over this document before the meeting.
look out	uważać	Look out! There's a car coming.
look around	rozejrzeć się	She looked around the new neighborhood to get a sense of it.
look up	sprawdzić (np. w słowniku)	You can look up unfamiliar words in the dictionary.
look up to	podziwiać	He looks up to his father for guidance.

Phrasal verbs with **break**

Phrasal verb	Tłumaczenie	Przykładowe zdanie
break away	oderwać sie	The prisoner managed to break away from his captors.

break down	zepsuć się	The car broke down on the way to the airport.
break in	włamać się	Someone tried to break in last night.
break into	włamać się do	Burglars broke into the house while we were on vacation.
break off	zerwać (np. rozmowę), odłamać się	They broke off their engagement. / A piece of the mirror broke off.
break open	otworzyć (siłą)	The firefighters had to break open the door to rescue the people inside.
break out	wybuchnąć	Violence broke out at the protest.
break through	przebić się przez	The sun broke through the clouds.
break up	rozstać się, rozwiązać (np. związek)	They decided to break up after years of being together.

Phrasal verbs with **turn**

Phrasal verb	Tłumaczenie	Przykładowe zdanie
turn around	obrócić się, zmienić na lepsze	The company's fortunes began to turn around after the new CEO took over.
turn away	odwrócić się, odprawić	The bouncer turned away people who didn't have tickets.
turn back	zawrócić, cofnąć się	We had to turn back because of the flooded road.
turn down	odrzucić, ściszyć	She turned down the job offer because it didn't pay enough. / Can you turn down the volume?

turn in	oddać (np. pracę), pójść spać	He turned in his essay to the teacher. / It's getting late; I think I'll turn in soon.
turn off	wyłączyć	Don't forget to turn off the lights before you leave.
turn on	włączyć	He turned on the TV to watch the game.
turn out	okazać się, wyjść	The party turned out to be a great success.
turn over	przewrócić, przekazać	She turned over in bed and went back to sleep. / Please turn over your papers when you're finished.
turn up	pojawić się, podgłośnić	He turned up unexpectedly at the party. / Can you turn up the radio a bit?

Phrasal verbs with **bring**

Phrasal verb	Tłumaczenie	Przykładowe zdanie
bring about	spowodować, wywołać	The new policy brought about positive changes in the company.
bring along	przynieść ze sobą	Don't forget to bring along your umbrella; it might rain.
bring back	przywrócić, przypominać	The song brings back memories of my childhood.
bring down	obniżyć, powalić	They managed to bring down the high prices. / The scandal brought down the politician's career.
bring forward	przedstawić	She brought forward a new idea during the meeting.
bring in	przynieść, zarobić	The new product brought in a lot of revenue.

bring off	osiągnąć coś trudnego	They brought off a stunning victory in the final game.
bring out	wydobyć, wprowadzić na rynek	The company brought out a new line of smartphones.
bring round	przekonać, ocucić	We finally managed to bring him round to our point of view.
bring up	wychowywać, poruszyć (temat)	She was brought up by her grandparents. / He brought up the issue during the meeting.
bring together	zgromadzić, zjednoczyć	The charity event brought together people from all walks of life.

Phrasal verbs with **cut**

Phrasal verb	Tłumaczenie	Przykładowe zdanie
cut across	skracać przez coś	We can cut across the park to get to the other side of town faster.
cut down (on)	ograniczać	He's trying to cut down on his sugar intake.
cut in	wcinać się, przerywać	She cut in line at the grocery store.
cut off	odciąć, odizolować	The storm cut off power to the entire neighborhood.
cut out	wyciąć, wyeliminować	She cut out sugar from her diet.
cut up	pokroić na kawałki	He cut up the vegetables for the soup.

Phrasal verbs with set

Phrasal verb	Tłumaczenie	Przykładowe zdanie
set about	zabrać się do czegoś	They set about cleaning the house early in the morning.

set aside	odłożyć na bok, przeznaczyć	She set aside some money for emergencies.
set back	opóźniać, przesuwać	The bad weather set back the construction schedule.
set down	odłożyć, zanotować	He set down his thoughts in a journal.
set forth	wyruszać, przedstawiać	The explorers set forth on their journey.
set in	nastać, zapanować	Winter has set in early this year.
set off	wyruszać, wywołać	They set off on their trip early in the morning. / His remark set off a heated debate.
set on/upon	zaatakować, nasilić	The dogs set upon the intruder.
set out	wyruszać, rozpoczynać	We set out on our hike at dawn.
set straight	wyprostować, wyjaśnić	She set him straight on the facts.
set up	założyć, uruchomić	They set up a new business together.
set up for	przygotować coś dla kogoś	They set up the conference room for the meeting.
